

# Clive Parish Plan refresh – completed 2014

## Summary

### Services, facilities and businesses

- Existing facilities well-used and appreciated.
- Majority of respondents prefer to support local services and businesses.
- Respondents would welcome additional facilities, including a walking group and a children's play area.

### Leisure, recreation and education

- Most respondents aware of leisure activities available.
- Daytime leisure activities well-used and supported.
- Support for more evening activities, and for events to attract wider range of participants.
- Suggestions include: Coffee mornings, musical events, computer courses, exercise classes, activities for young people (highlighted as a particular gap).

### Housing and development

- Majority of respondents agreed that any new housing developments should be small clusters of less than 5 and be sensitive to the surroundings.
- Strong support for affordable housing to buy or rent, which would attract young people and families to the area.
- Support for sheltered accommodation, including extra care housing.

### Communication

- Mobile and television signal poor . over 50% of respondents dissatisfied.
- Notice boards and Clive and Grinshill Newsletter good sources of information.
- More advertising of events would be useful . possibly WhatsApp page in newsletter, dedicated part of notice boards.
- Some form of Contact Directory for clubs and groups would be useful.
- Support for use of online communication . social media, websites, electronic newsletter.

### Transport and traffic

- Majority of respondents use own transport or walk.
- Current public transport (bus and train) rated as good.

- Concern about parking issues, particularly by GP surgery (school) and also junction to Wem road. Dangerous for pedestrians, especially children.
- 20mph zone suggested near school.
- Potholes and drainage issues on roads causing some concern.

### Environment

- Litter, fly-tipping and vandalism not a problem in general.
- Some concerns about dog fouling.
- Green issues important to residents . recycling collection appreciated.
- Some consensus to explore renewable energy options.
- Current conservation work good, hedgerows well-maintained.
- Some support for providing dedicated cycle tracks around Grinshill, to improve safety for cyclists and walkers.
