Neighbourhood Plan

The Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group still needs more volunteers in order to get started on the first real stage of the process, which is to designate the area that the Neighbourhood Plan will cover. Highways update

- We are thrilled to announce we have been successful in our application to West Mercia Police for funding for a vehicle activated speed sign. The aim is to encourage compliance to the 30mph speed limit in the village, and ultimately make the village safer for pedestrians, cyclists, and other road users. We are waiting for the funds to arrive and making arrangements for installation, but we hope to have this up and running before too long.
- If you haven't already expressed an interest in joining the Community Speed Watch programme
 please do get in touch. This will work in tandem with the speed sign above, and volunteers will
 use hand-held speed devices to monitor the speed of vehicles from specified safe locations, and
 submit data collected to the police. Anyone over 18 can become a volunteer, so if you want to
 make our roads safer for everyone in Clive, please get in touch with the Council clerk or one of
 your councillors.
- The pot holes on Sansaw straight have finally been tackled, but please do raise concerns about road conditions with your councillors, or directly with the clerk.

Automated External Defibrillator (AED) Scheme

We are still looking for more volunteers to join the AED Scheme. If you would be interested in receiving free training in CPR and using the AED, please contact the Council clerk directly.

Parish Paths Partnership (P3)

The Grinshill and Clive P3 volunteers have been walking and clearing footpaths in the area over the last couple of months, and thanks to their suggestions, we are already seeing improvements to accessibility, with two new gates being installed along footpaths. P3 is a collaboration with Shropshire Council, who provide training, tools, guidance, and insurance for clearing and maintaining footpaths in the Clive and Grinshill area.
